

## What Makes The NEO Plus Different From the NEO2?

Though the machines look very much alike, there are some key differences between the two models, with the most obvious feature being the advanced Color LCD Control Panel which provides instant visual feedback about each job. As the saying goes, “a picture paints a thousand words” and in the case of embroidery production, a picture can save thousands of dollars in terms of mistakes and lost production! Here are some key advantages of the NEO Plus over the NEO2

- **More memory.** The NEO Plus holds 2,000,000 stitches or 200 designs vs. 680,000 stitches or 99 designs for the NEO2.
- **Automatic rotation of the designs when in cap mode.** When in the cap embroidery mode, the design will be seen upside down on the screen, just as it appears on the cap.
- **Color Pallet.** If your thread colors are set up correctly you will instantly see if you have chosen the wrong needle when setting up design color sequence.
- **More precise design rotation.** You can rotate a design by degree with the NEO Plus, instead of in 45 degree increments on the NEO2
- **Cleanup function.** This useful tool allows you to remove stitches that are too close to each other which means you can quickly eliminate unnecessary stitches without affecting the quality of the design. End result is fewer stitches and faster production times.
- **Real-time design view.** The NEO Plus control panel allows you to view the design as it sews and more importantly when you need to back up the design you can see exactly where in the design you are at without having to guess.
- **Internal electronics.** All of the machine electronics are built-in, whereas on the NEO2, they are contained in an external unit that plugs into the machine via a cable. Everything is simpler and more compact with the NEO Plus.
- **Standby function.** You can put the machine in standby mode while you are away from it which ensures that everything will be exactly as you left it when you return.
- **Reporting function.** This feature provides feedback about machine performance including error codes, which greatly simplifies troubleshooting. Also can view the design properties at the machine to verify that everything is centered and setup correctly.
- **Design folders.** Multiple design folders in the control panel make it easy to sort, separate and store designs in a sensible manner. For example, you could put all your cap designs in one folder or maybe you have a large collection of designs belonging to one customer that you run frequently. You could easily store them all on one individual folder.
- **Intuitive controls.** The machine functions of the NEO Plus are easier to access and operate than they are on the NEO2. Large, clearly identified buttons and plus the jog control keep things running smoothly for your machine operators. And of course, the color LCD screen gives instant feedback and information about control functions and features.

- **Head On/Off Switch.** This feature allows you to run the machine without stitching which is very useful for moving forward and backward through a design without sewing taking place.
- **Sturdier construction.** While the NEO2 is a very well-built machine, the NEO Plus has a sturdier stand, which minimizes vibration during sewing.
